2026/529 - Crime figures for anti-social behaviour along the Flintshire Coastal Path

In response to your recent request for information regarding;

Can you please provide figures for the number of recorded incidents of anti-social behaviour and related crimes, including use of motorised vehicles (off-road bikes, quads, electric bikes etc) along the full length of the Flintshire Coastal Park from Saltney to Talacre, between April 1, 2025 and March 31, 2026.

Can you also provide figures for the same area, for the year April 1 2024 to March 31, 2025 please.

There were no Flintshire Events 01/04/2024 to 31/03/2026 with "Coastal Park/Path" or "Coast Park/Path" in the address fields.

However, we carried out a Key Word (KW) search of all Flintshire events with final disposal type "ASB", "Crime" or "Transport" + KW search of event comments for "Coastal Path/Park" or "Coast Path/Park below". These occurrences were manually checked and four incidents recorded relevant to your request.

Can you also confirm how much money and police time has been spent on policing the coastal park in each of the time periods requested and how many incidents in each period have led to successful prosecutions please?
